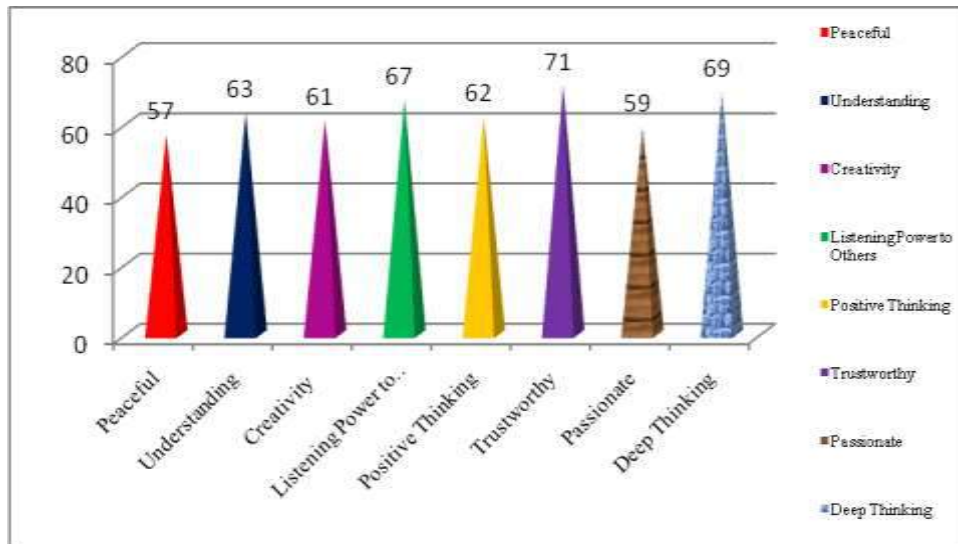


Chart-1: Status of Positive Impacts of Introvert Persons

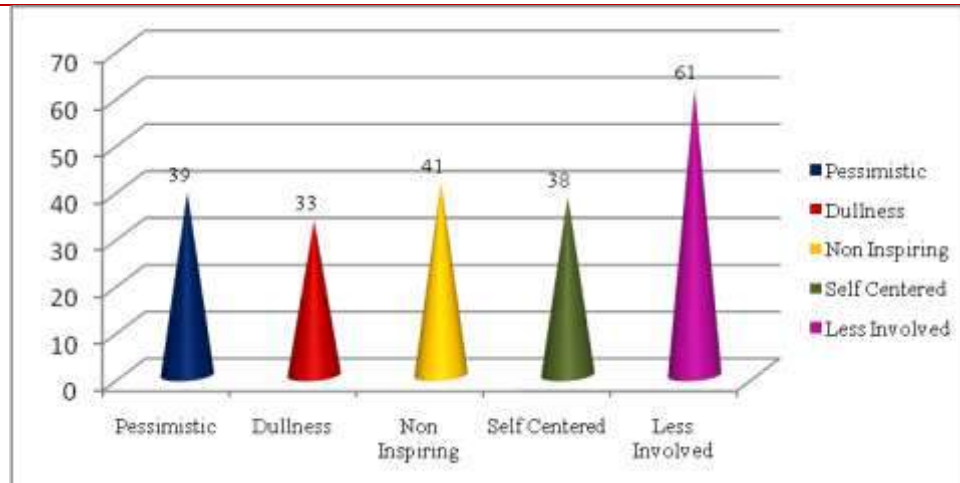


Chart-2: Status of Negative Impacts of Introvert Persons

Data table shows that introvert persons make society peaceful favored by 57%, understanding supported by 63%, creativity power got 61% positive view. They have power of listening to others got 67% positive view. Introvert persons have ability of positive thinking supported by 62% persons. Trustworthiness, passionate and deep thinking got 71%, 59% and 69% respectively. Thus hypothesis 1, there is no significant positive impact of introvert candidates on development of society is rejected.

Introvert person's pessimistic impact was favored by 39%, dullness was marked by 33%, non inspiring nature got 41% support. In the matter of self centeredness 38% persons expressed positive view while nature of less involvement got 61% favor. Hence hypothesis 2, there is no significant negative impact of introvert candidates on development of society is accepted.

Conclusion:

Introverts are interesting persons filled with so many qualities that are important for development of society. They have mental peace and behave peacefully which is primary need of our society. They have imagination power, creativity, better understanding and ability to listen others. They are inspiring for others also. They teach how to respect other's thoughts, feelings and work.
